\*Students with 60 or more transfer credits at time of transfer are waived from the Multilingual Communication T1 requirement. Students with 30-59 initial transfer credits are waived if they completed Level 3 of a foreign language in high school **OR** must complete Level 2 (Elementary II) foreign language in college. Students with 29 initial transfer credits or less must complete an Intermediate I level language in college.

# Science courses can be chosen in two ways. The first way is to take courses from Natural World I and II above. These courses will transfer whether or not both courses are taken. The second way is to take TWO courses from the Middlesex TAP-vetted course list, one of which must be a lab course. If using the TAP-vetted courses, two courses are required, one from the Scientific Reasoning list and one from the Scientific Knowledge list, and, one must be a lab course.
